



Call Before You Dig

Smart digging means calling 811 before each job!

Anyone planning to do any type of digging project should call JULIE (Joint Utility Locating Information for Excavators) before digging.

Homeowners often make risky assumptions about whether or not they should get their utility lines marked, but every digging job requires a call – even small projects. The depth of utility lines varies and there may be multiple utility lines in a common area. Digging without calling can disrupt service to an entire neighborhood, harm you and those around you and potentially result in fines and repair costs. Calling 811 before every digging job gets your underground utility lines marked for free and helps prevent undesired consequences.

Now it's even easier to reach JULIE simply by dialing 811. This three-digit number is easy to remember. In addition, callers can still contact JULIE using their traditional toll-free number:
